

## **21 Day Corporate Fast**

We are pressing in with prayer and fasting for a move of God in our lives and in our church. We are asking God to double these kingdom expressions by the 50th church anniversary. Let's pray that He would bring us into greater alignment for increased kingdom impact.

- Double disciples
- Double servants
- Double leaders
- Double missions/outreach
- Double ministry

### ***Fasting***

Fasting is a period of time dedicated to prayer and seeking the Lord. During a fast you usually abstain from food for a period of time or refrain from entertainment. Fasting allows us to suppress our flesh and enter into the spirit. Ask the Lord what He desires for you to fast during the 21 days.

*My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me. John 10:27*

Expect to hear His perspective!

Keep a notebook to write down any impressions or words that the Lord gives you.

Write decrees with the Lord.

Pray for the will of the Lord to be fulfilled in your life and in our church.

*And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love Him, who have been called according to his purpose. Romans 8:28*

# Decree

**You will also decide *and* decree a thing, and it will be established for you;  
And the light [of God's favor] will shine upon your ways. Job 22:28**

God has given us authority to take His Word and to decree it and to establish it with power over our lives. Own it and speak it! This will strengthen your faith, renew your mind, and will release His Kingdom over our church and throughout our world. These Scriptures are formatted for you to decree and are taken from the NIV, ESV and Amplified versions.

**Nov. 1- 2 Chronicles 7:14**

As we humble ourselves and pray and seek God's face and turn from our wicked ways, God will hear from heaven and will forgive our sin and heal our land.

**Nov 2- James 5:16**

The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working! (My prayers are powerful!)

**Nov 3- Ephesians 2:18**

I have direct access to God through the Spirit.

**Nov 4- 1 John 5:14**

I have confidence toward him, that if I ask anything according to his will, He hears me.

**Nov 5- Matthew 17:20**

As I have faith like a grain of mustard seed, I will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move, and nothing will be impossible for me.

**Nov 6- John 1:12**

I have received him, I have believed in his name, and he has given me the right to become a child of God.

**Nov 7- 2 Corinthians 1:21-22**

God makes me stand firm in Christ. He anointed me and set his seal of ownership on me, and put his Spirit in my heart as a deposit, guaranteeing what is to come.

**Nov 8- Hebrews 12:1-2**

I lay aside every weight and sin which clings so closely, and I run with endurance the race that is set before me, looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of my faith, who

for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God.

**Nov 9-** Romans 8:37

In all these things I am more than a conqueror *and* gain an overwhelming victory through Him who loved me [so much that He died for me].

**Nov 10-** 2 Tim 1:7

God did not give me a spirit of timidity *or* cowardice *or* fear, but [He has given me a spirit] of power and of love and of sound judgment *and personal* discipline [abilities that result in a calm, well-balanced mind and self-control].

**Nov 11-** Matthew 6:33

I will seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and He will take care of the other things.

**Nov 12-** Matthew 5:14

I am the light of [Christ to] the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden.

**Nov 13-** John 15:16

He has chosen me and has appointed *and* placed *and* purposefully planted me, so that I would go and bear fruit *and* keep on bearing, and that my fruit will remain *and* be lasting, so that whatever I ask of the Father in His name [as His representative] He will give to me.

**Nov 14-** Isaiah 61:1

The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me, because the Lord has anointed *and* commissioned me to bring good news to the humble *and* afflicted; He has sent me to bind up [the wounds of] the brokenhearted, To proclaim release [from confinement and condemnation] to the [physical and spiritual] captives and freedom to prisoners, To proclaim ]the favorable year of the Lord.

**Nov 15-** Acts 1:8

I receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon me; and I am His witness to the ends of the earth.

**Nov 16-** Matthew 6:10

May your Kingdom come. May your will be done on earth, as it is in heaven!

**Nov 17-** Ephesians 5:18-19

We will be filled with the Spirit, speaking to one another with psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit. We will sing and make music from our hearts to the Lord!

**Nov 18-** Psalm 47:1-2

Clap your hands, all you nations; shout to God with cries of joy. For the LORD Most High is awesome, the great King over all the earth!

**Nov 19-** 2 Corinthians 3:17

The Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. We welcome the Spirit who leads us to freedom!

**Nov 20-** Psalm 86:11

Teach us your way, LORD, that we may rely on your faithfulness; give us undivided hearts, that we may fear your name.

**Nov 21-** Zephaniah 3:17

The LORD our God is in our midst, He is the mighty one who will save; he will rejoice over us with gladness; he will quiet us by his love and exult over us with loud singing!
